This reduction is available only to first-year teachers.		

First-year teachers who have been members of the Indiana Student Education Association (ISEA) or some other state student education association and/or the Student National Education Association (SNEA) are eligible for reduced dues at the state and national level.

The dues reduction is handled in two different ways. Former state student education association members receive a \$25 reduction in ISTA membership dues for each year he/she was a member, to a maximum of \$100. This is an immediate reduction in the ISTA dues charged to the new member.

Former ISEA members are eligible for a \$20 per year reduction in NEA membership; however, the new member is charged the regular NEA dues and given a rebate directly from NEA to the member.

New members who take advantage of the reduced dues must place either a "1," "2," "3," or "4" on the membership form below "TOTAL," noting the number of years the individual was a member of the student association.

In order for the first-year teacher to take advantage of this dues reduction, he/she must show evidence of membership in the student association. The evidence could be either a membership card or a cancelled check to the organization.

Once the Association Representative has confirmed the first-year teacher has been a member of a student education association, the individual will receive the ISTA reduction.
